Four-Seasons' Gardens Presentation

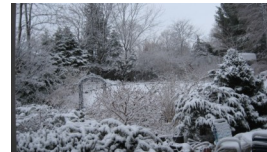

Carved watermelon basket filled with a variety of fruits.

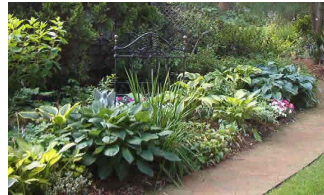
Fruit Flowers

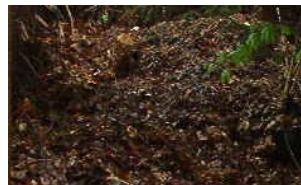


Cornucopia Live Centerpiece Workshop
